## The rules for the authors.

- 1. One copy of the article the volume of which is not less than 0.35 printed sheet (14 000-20 000 printed characters, including blank characters between words, punctuation marks, numbers, etc.) in Russian (Belarusian) language should be sent as a non-registered (certified) letter to the address: 247760, Gomel region, Mozyr, Studentcheskaya Street, 28, room 114. (247760 Гомельская обл., г. Мозырь,ул. Студенческая, 28, к. 114.) The text should be typed on a computer machinery in text-based editor (Word 97, 2000, 2003 for Windows); font Times New Roman, 14 pt; single line spacing, paragraph indention 1.27 cm; signatures to photos, graphics, pictures, letters diagrams should be printed in TimesNewRoman.
- 2. In the left upper corner the UDC index is put.
- 3. After single-space the title in capital letters without hyphenation and separation of the preposition from the noun. The title should be short. It should determine the area of the study made and correspond to the contents.
- 4. The initials and surname of the author(s) are single-space and should be printed in the middle of the page. Further goes information about the author (surname, first name in full, academic degree and title, place of work, position, contact address, work and home telephone numbers, for graduate students information about the supervisor).
- 5. A single-space down the descriptive notes are printed (up to 10 lines) in the language of the article which should set forth the contents of the article, then a single-space down after the paragraph indent one should print the text of the article with the following structure: introduction, the results of research done and their discussion, graphics and other illustrations when needed; clear stated conclusions. Additionally the purpose and methods of the research may be included in the structure of the article after the introduction.
- 6. Terminology, basic concepts, language material for analysis or as examples are printed in bold type or in italics.
- 7. Margins left, right, bottom, upper 30 mm each.
- 8. Attached to the article:
  - a) recommendation of department, scientific laboratory or institution (extract from the records of the meeting);
  - b) certified with a seal review of specialist in a certain sphere, having a scientific degree;
  - c) a resume in English;
  - d) list of symbols and abbreviations accepted in the article;
  - e) typescript in electronic format (CD, DVD, etc.).

- 9. List of cited sources is at the end of the text under the heading "Literature» should be submitted in accordance with the rules of registration of the bibliographic list of the dissertation research (GOST 7.1-2003).
- 10. Links are enumerated according to the citing order in the text. Serial numbers of links are written in square brackets (eg. [1], [2]). In the brackets after the serial number references, separated by commas, with no cuts like p. or pge. the page (or pages) of the cites is indicated with a number (or numbers) (eg. [3, 14], [5, 10-12]).
- 11. In the special vocabulary and terminology, as well in the proper names the accuracy of transmission of the letters 'e' and 'ë' is not required. The editorial staff of the magazine conducts an independent examination, which is one of the basic conditions of publishing of received manuscripts. The main criteria for evaluation are novelty, urgency and information value of the material. If the manuscript under advice of a reviewer is returned for revision, the reconsideration date of receipt of the Editorial staff is considered to be the day of delivery to the editor of the corrected version.

The editorship has the right to reject the article without explanation, if a significant part of its contents doesn't correspond to the specialization of the magazine.

Scientific articles of graduate or doctoral students in the last year of their education or applicants before defense are published out of turn.

We ask authors to take into account the statute of HAC (Higher Attestation Committee) of impermissibility of offering to editorship articles published before or works accepted for publication by other editions.

The publication of scientific articles is free of charge.
